Quick Certificate Installation Guide

Thank you for purchasing a Honeywell 35 Series Network Video Recorder. The NVR uses HTTPS, a secure communication protocol that verifies the identities of visited websites and servers and encrypts data exchanged between the client and the server.

When you log in to the NVR web client for the first time, some browsers may display a warning that the connection is not private/secure.

The installation of the security certificate involves the below step:

- Logging in

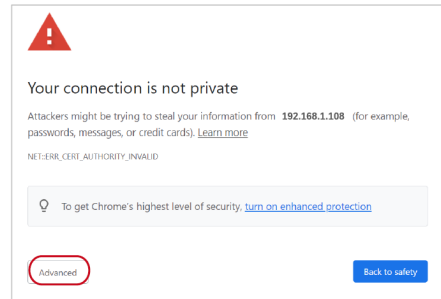

- 1 Open your browser and enter the NVR's IP address in the address bar.



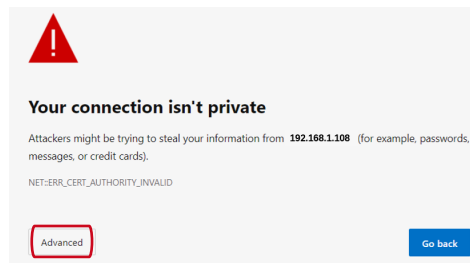
- 2a If you are using Chrome, a message appears warning that the connection is not private. Click **Advanced**.



- Click **Proceed to 192.168.1.108 (unsafe)**.



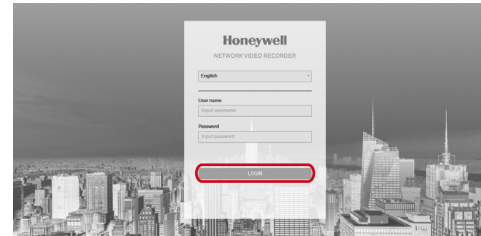
- 2b If you are using Microsoft Edge, a message appears warning of a problem with the website's security certificate. Click **Advanced**.



- Click **Continue to 192.168.1.108 (unsafe)**.



- 3 In the login window, enter your username and password.
